## STEP 2 Hire

(OPTIONAL – If you do not wish to hire an instrument, move to Step 3)

## STEP 3 Lesson Type

### Individual

- Rotational \$25 / lesson Lessons are conducted during class time
- Fixed \$30 / lesson Lessons are conducted at lunchtimes, before school (8.00am – 9.00am), or after school (3.30pm – 5.00pm) **with the exception of voice and guitar available only before school and during lunchtime**

### Paired

GUITAR AND BASS GUITAR ONLY

- Rotational \$20 / lesson Lessons are conducted during class time
- Fixed \$25 / lesson Lessons are conducted at lunchtimes, before school (8.00am - 9.00am), or after school (3.13 pm - 4.45 pm) **with the exception of voice and guitar available only before /after school and/or during lunchtime/recess.**

### ALLOCATION OF LESSONS and ENSEMBLE PROGRAM

1. Paired lessons **not** available for piano, voice or drum kit.
2. If **Paired lessons** are selected and no partner is nominated, **Individual (Rotational)** lessons will be allocated.
3. Fixed lessons times are extremely limited and are allocated primarily to **senior music students** (Years 12 & 11), then on a first come, first served basis. Where fixed lessons times are not available, **Individual (Rotational)** lessons will be allocated.
4. **Ensemble rehearsals** for students of both **voice and guitar** will be scheduled either during **lunchtime** or **after school** between **3.15 to 3.45** as per tutor timetable. These times are subject to change based on tutor timetable needs.

- Students are responsible for taking care of instruments hired from the school and will be liable for the replacement value if vandalism or serious damage is incurred.
- Lost instruments are the responsibility of the student. If an instrument is lost it should be reported to the Director of Performing Arts immediately. The cost to replace the instrument will be forwarded to the parents of the student.
- All instruments are to be returned to the College **by the end** of the hire agreement.
- Students are responsible for the purchase of any additional equipment required for the care of their instrument. (i.e. strings, sticks etc...)
