Student Responsibilities and Code of Conduct for Bus Travel

It is every student's responsibility to behave in a manner that ensures the safety and comfort of passengers and driver. Matters of safety and student conduct are viewed seriously. All students who travel on the Kolbe buses must read, agree and sign, in conjunction with their parent/guardian the Student Responsibilities and Code of Conduct for Bus Travel.

Purpose

The Student Responsibilities and Code of Conduct for Bus Travel seeks to:

- Provide safe environments for students to arrive and leave the school
- · Take all reasonable measures to ensure the safety of students travelling by bus
- Provide clear guidance for students on the expectations of how to behave on the bus and at bus stops.

Expectations

Students are expected to:

- Adhere to the College Code of Conduct at all times whilst Uniform, on school property or travelling on school buses
- Respect other people and property
- \cdot Wait for the bus and alight from the bus in a responsible and orderly manner
- Take responsibility for their own conduct, and maintain a respectful and safe manner whilst on the bus
- Follow all reasonable directions of drivers immediately, particularly in the case of an emergency or a breakdown.

These expected behaviours, including specific examples, are outlined in the table below.

Respect other	\cdot Treat other people and their possessions with care, consideration and respect
people and property	• Respect bus property/equipment by not causing damage and reporting vandalism.
Wait for the bus in a	\cdot Wait back at a safe distance from the bus/roadway until it stops
responsible and	Stand quietly without calling out or shouting
orderly manner	Refrain from pushing other people in line
Take responsibility	• Carry your bus pass at all times
for their own	\cdot Stay in your seat and, once seated, avoid movement around the bus
conduct, and	• Keep arms, legs and heads inside the bus
maintain a	• Store school bags under the seat
respectful and safe	Refrain from throwing objects around the bus
manner whilst on	• Refrain from attracting the attention of the driver except in the case of emergency
the bus	• Speak quietly to people around you; refrain from shouting or yelling
	Always wear the seatbelt provided
	• Refrain from putting your feet on the seats
	• Refrain from eating or drinking (except water) on the bus
	• Use appropriate language at all times; offensive language will not be tolerated
	Use mobile devices/electronically devices responsibly
Use designated bus	It is the responsibility of students to disembark at their correct designated stop

Exit the bus in an	• Wait until the bus stops before standing or removing their seat belt to disembark
orderly fashion	• Exit the bus in a quiet and orderly fashion
	• Wait until the bus has moved away before crossing the road; never cross the road in
	front of the bus
	· Use crossings or traffic lights if available

Breaches of behaviour expectation on the College Bus

Student misbehaviour on the College Bus will result in the Director of Students and/or the Deputy Principal being notified. Parents will be notified of any significant breaches of expectations.

Breaches may result in:

- Warning
- \cdot A written apology
- \cdot Temporary suspension of bus pass
- \cdot Permanent suspension of bus pass
- · Additional disciplinary action, depending on the gravity of the offence

As part of the booking process parents and students must read and agree to the Student Responsibilities and Code of Conduct for Bus Travel and the behaviour expected and any consequences that may ensue from failure to comply the expectations outlined above.
